

LRPA Scholarships

All applicants must:

- Submit a typed application form and include a resume detailing employment and volunteer experience.
- Provide an official transcript from all universities/schools attended for GPA verification.
- Must meet additional requirements of the scholarship for which they are applying.
- Must be present at the LRPA awards banquet to accept the scholarship.
- Must have submitted application by the deadline date.

Wayne Robichaux Scholarship: \$500

- Applicants may be junior or senior undergraduate students with a major or emphasis in leisure studies, recreation & parks, sports administration, therapeutic recreation or related fields.
- Have at least an accumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better for the last three (3) semesters.
- Applicants must include two (2) letters of recommendations, one from a current instructor and one from an employer, professional reference, or volunteer supervisor.

Biddy Kincade Scholarship: \$500

- Applicant must be in good standing as a LRPA member or a child of a good standing LRPA member.
- Applicants may be an incoming freshman, undergrad or graduate student at an institution of higher learning and must have a grade point average of 2.5 or above.
- Have demonstrated exceptional professional involvement at the local, state, regional, and/or national levels. Involvement may include belonging to professional organizations, serving as a room host at conferences, serving on committees, holding an office in a student association, or attending symposia or national conferences.
- Applicants must include two (2) letters of recommendations from practicing professionals, one personal and one professional.

LRPA Board Scholarship: \$500

- Student must be attending a Baton Rouge Institution of higher learning
- Student must be pursuing a degree in leisure studies, recreation & parks, sports administration, therapeutic recreation or related fields.
- Student must have a GPA of 2.5 or above in majoring classes.
- Two letters of recommendation must be included, one personal and one professional.
